## STEMI Care Bundle



Each month NHS trusts monitor their performance in the delivery of care bundles, and report it nationally to NHS England. Using this data, NHS England are able to monitor the standard of care delivered to STEMI patients. NHS England has developed a STEMI care bundle, which specifically outlines key components that provide the best evidence-based care for this particular patient group, and must be undertaken for each patient who is having an ST elevation MI.

Component of care bundle	Exceptions
Aspirin given	<ul> <li>Patient refusal</li> <li>Contraindication to drug</li> <li>Cautions if clear reason provided</li> <li>Doctor (e.g GP / Cardiologist) advised not to provide aspirin (GMC number provided and documented)</li> </ul>
Glyceryl Trinitrate (GTN) given	<ul> <li>Patient refusal</li> <li>Contraindication to drug</li> <li>No chest pain</li> <li>Systolic BP &lt;90mmHg</li> </ul>
Two pain scores recorded	<ul> <li>Patient refusal</li> <li>Patient unable to</li> <li>Patient condition - e.g unconscious</li> </ul>
Appropriate analgesia given - options available are Morphine, Paracetamol, Entonox	<ul> <li>Patient refusal</li> <li>Patient not in pain</li> <li>Contraindication to drug(s)</li> <li>Cautions if clear reasons provided</li> </ul>
